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Q. Do I need to make a Building Control application to build a detached garage?

No, provided it does not exceed 30m2 in floor area and is either built substantially of non-combustible material or is not less than one metre from a dwelling or boundary of the site or a road.

Q. Do I need to make a Building Control application to build an attached garage?

Yes, but a carport, open on at least two sides, or a covered way or similar structure at ground level is exempt, provided it does not exceed 30m2 in area.

Q. Do I need to make a Building Control application to convert an attached garage into a room?

Yes, consideration of damp proofing, ventilation, means of escape and fire detection are some of the things that will need to be considered. Professional advice should be sought.

Q. Do I need Building Control Approval for a Small Detached Building

- (A) A detached single storey building, having a floor area which does not exceed 30m2, which contains no sleeping accommodation and is a building which is either—
 - (i) constructed substantially of non-combustible material; or
 - (ii) at no point less than 1 m from—
 - (aa) the nearest point of a dwelling;
 - (bb) the nearest part of a road; or
 - (cc) the nearest point of the boundary of the land on which it is to be erected.
- (B) A detached single storey building, having a floor area which does not exceed 15m2, which contains no sleeping accommodation and is not less than 1 m from a dwelling
